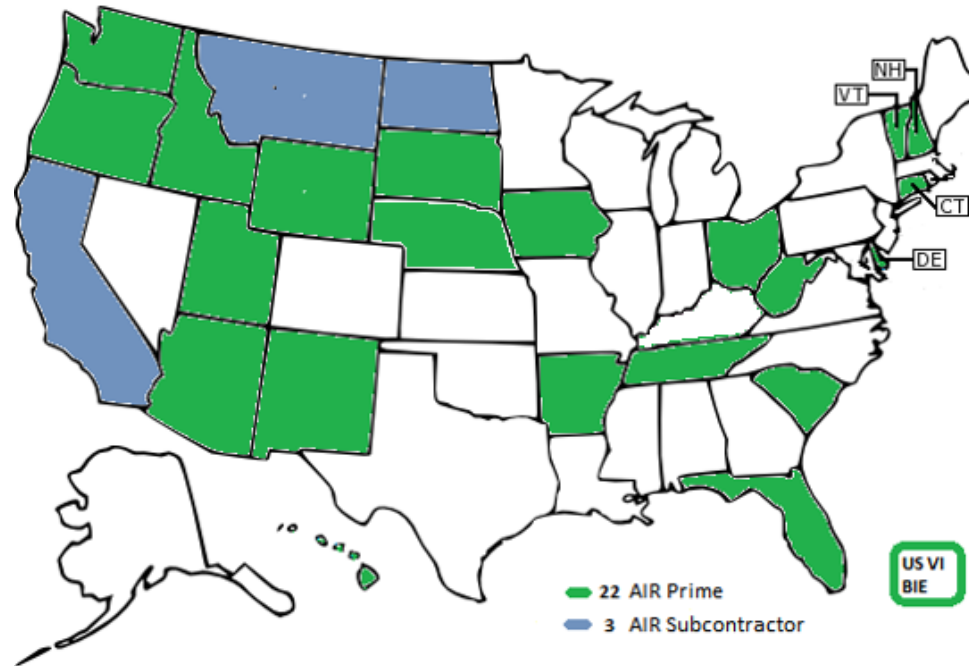

  - ▶ Summative: Spring 2019 test
    - ▶ 2019 Testing Window: March 19, 2019-June 7, 2019
- ▶ Aligned to New Hampshire's content standards

# AIR Testing Systems

- ▶ **Assessment Portal** - Access to all systems and resources.
- ▶ **Secure Browser** - Secure testing application; required to be installed on each system used for testing; blocks any outside access to other systems.
- ▶ **Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE)** - User and Student management including test settings and accommodations. Administrative tasks such as appeals, participation reports, etc.
- ▶ **Test Delivery System (TDS)** - The testing system, both the student and teacher interface
- ▶ **AIR Ways Reporting** - Reporting system for Interims and Benchmark Modular assessments
- ▶ **Assessment Viewing Application (AVA)** - View Interim Assessments prior to administering them
- ▶ **Online Reporting System (ORS)** - Reporting system for summative assessments


# Standard Setting - July 2017

- ▶ Since 17-18 was the first operational year for the NH SAS, cut-scores and proficiency levels needed to be set - this process is called Standard Setting
- ▶ NH DOE wanted to continued to provide the field with real-time reporting, so preliminary scores, based on prior testing, were released during the school year.
- ▶ Over 250 New Hampshire educators participated in the process and recommended cut scores for all grades/subjects to the Commissioner of Education and the DOE.
- ▶ Once approved, update reports with the approved cut-scores and proficiency ranges were released to the Online Reporting System (ORS)
- ▶ Since the Science test was brand new in 17-18, scores were held until the official cut-scores and proficiency levels were approved by the NH DOE.
- ▶ Science scores were released in August 2017 and are still available in ORS.

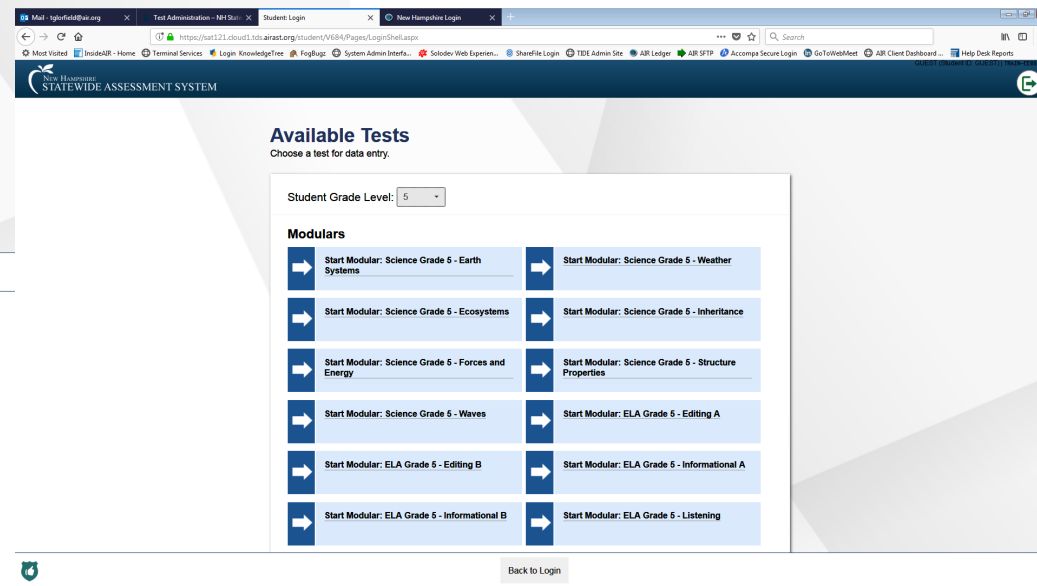
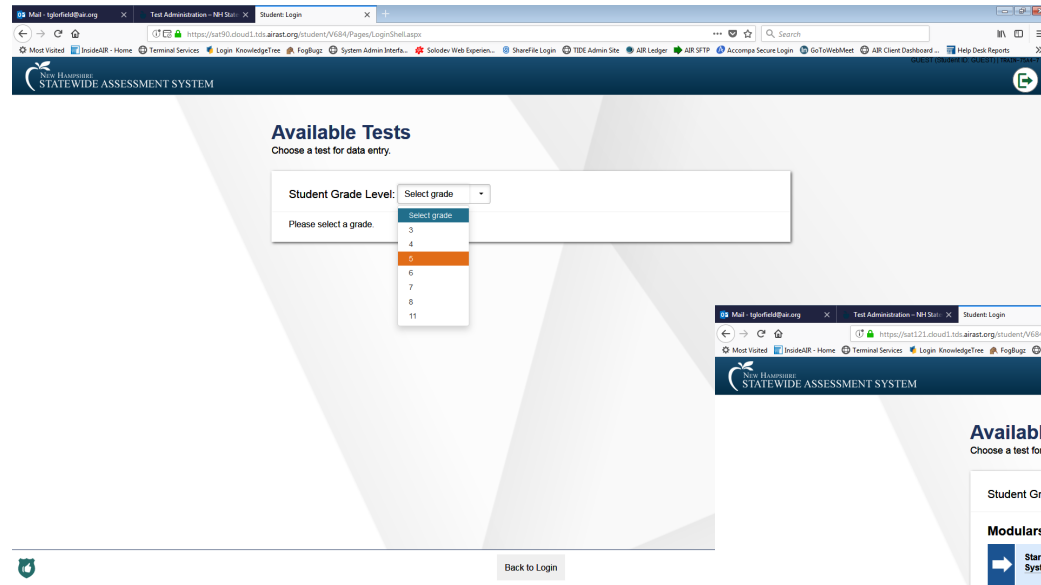
