This spring, your child participated in the New Hampshire Statewide Assessment System (NH SAS) assessment in English Language Arts (to include writing) and mathematics in grades 3-8 and in science for students in grades 5, 8 and 11.

This assessment is a summative snapshot of a student's grade level academic achievement. Individual student scores are one of several measures that are used to help teachers and families understand student progress and readiness for the next academic school year. The overall NH SAS score presents a measure of how well a student is performing against the grade level academic standards that guide instruction. All NH SAS student results are immediately available to teachers and school administrators upon student completion of the test.

We are sending home your child's Individual Student Report for your records. This is a great opportunity for you to review your child's progress and to use the information on the report as discussion points with your child's teachers. Please do not hesitate to contact the school with any questions.
